

Armed Forces Day 5 K Run/Walk

RULES & REGULATIONS

COURSE: The established course is a measured 5,000 meter (5K) course, and is marked at the start, finish, and at one mile increments. Participants must remain cognizant of vehicular traffic and adhere to instructions from course officials. Course officials will be stationed at key points along the course to provide traffic control, observe participant compliance of course rules, and act as safety controls. Any course official is fully authorized to take any action necessary to preclude a safety hazard.

ELIGIBILITY: In order to be considered an eligible participant in this event:

- A signed entry form must be completed and registered by course officials prior to race start.
- The appropriate level entry fee must be paid.
- In the case of a minor, the entry form must be signed by the minor's parent or legal guardian.
- Participant must use any placard, number, or device required by the timing and placement officials.

TIMING AND PLACEMENT: An independent contractor has been hired to perform all timing and placement duties. This contractor shall provide primary and backup timing devices and is responsible for ensuring accurate timing and completion of placement rosters.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented to overall race winners and to age group winners according to the following criteria:

Awards will be presented to the top three finishers male and female based upon time. These six finishers will be withdrawn from the roster for age group placement purposes.

Awards will be presented to the top three finishers, male and female, based upon time and the following age groups:

6-10	11-15	16-20	21-25	26-30	31-35
36-40	41-45	46-50	51-55	56-60	61+

Placement in age groups will be based upon the participant's age on race day.

DISQUALIFICATION: Participants may be disqualified for any of the following reasons:

-Failure to follow course official directions.

-Failure to follow course route.

-Performance of an act or acts, which in the opinion of course officials may result in a safety hazard to other participants or officials.

-Failure to meet any of the eligibility requirements.

GRIEVANCES OR COMPLAINTS: Submit any grievance or complaint to the Commandant, Southern Indiana Leatherneck Detachment within 15 days after race day for resolution.
